

EYFS Curriculum Overview Nursery - Aspects of Learning

In Nursery children follow the EYFS curriculum each term. We cover all aspects each term through the provision in the setting and focus on specific areas of learning each half term. Our topics are centred around the children's areas of interest and learning styles and change regularly. Some children are in Nursery for 6 terms and so topics are not repeated in the same way each year. Our topics include - Welcome to Our Nursery, All About Me, Growing, We're going on an Animal Hunt, Light and Dark, Destinations, Fairy Tales, London - Our City, Space, Food, Pirates, Traditional Tales, Through the Magic Door, Around the World, Julia Donaldson and Mini-beasts.
