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2 Year Funding or Family Support Advice/Child Development Advice Book an appointment with Andrea, our Family Support Worker for any aspect of family support, child development or help and advice around 2 year old childcare funding.

Cooking with Toddlers – In this 10 week course you will spend two hours per week with your toddler (age 2-5) preparing fun and yummy dishes, such as smoothie, tasty toast, picturesque pizza, that you can take home to share with your family. In a friendly, informal atmosphere, you and your toddler will enjoy exploring ideas and developing knowledge based around each dish to build on the skills progressively. Booking is essential.

Create and Play is a drop-in session for all ages. Each week there will be different art and craft activities including messy play. As well as providing play opportunities, these sessions are great for your child's developing social and language skills; fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination and problem solving, planning and concentration skills. This is a free session.

Mini Marvels Music and Rhyme – Spend quality time with your little one in this structured lesson designed for all areas of development. Music, rhyme, colourful props and social interaction make this the perfect class for you to develop and learn together. Booking is essential and there is a £2 charge for each session.

Music with Toddlers – In this 10 week course, you and your child will enjoy musical activities, including movements to rhythmic patterns to aid motor and physical co-ordination skills. Booking is essential.

Share Family Learning is for parents and carers of school based children aged 4-6. During the course you will learn creative ideas and fun activities that help your child to improve their literacy and numeracy skills.

Toddler Get Active are sessions focusing on physical development and is an exciting and fun way of encouraging exercise. Sessions are aimed at very confident walkers. Booking is essential. This is a free session.

Baby Sensory Play – is a drop in session for babies up to 18 months. Come along and explore light, sound and touch with your baby. Soft toys, messy play and gentle music. Perfect for bonding. This is a free session. Please note 12 children maximum.

Triple P Course – This is a course on positive parenting exploring ways to manage your child's behaviour, fussy eating, sleep patterns, daily routines and many more aspects of family life.

Marvels Lane Children's Centre aims to provide inclusive services and activities for families with children, parents and carers of all abilities. All of our sessions are inclusive. The building is on one level, with no steps and a wheelchair accessible toilet.
