

## Apple and Koa Classes Home Learning Year 2

Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April

Hello everyone,

This term our topic is called 'Rainforests'. This is a Geography based topic and you will need to use atlases, the internet or ask an adult to complete the tasks. Each week we are going to send you 3 activities on a Monday and 3 activities on a Thursday which you can complete at home. These activities link to what we would have been doing in class. We hope you enjoy them and if you would like to, you can keep them in a folder, a book or send us photos of your work through our class e-mails.

Here are 3 activities to start you off this week.

### Rainforests

1. Our planet has been divided into areas according to their weather patterns. Find the line of the "Equator" and draw it on a world map (if you can print one). Show on the same world map that all rainforests are touching the line of the Equator and label them, (Clue: there are 3 main rainforests).  
**Extension** : Also locate the continents and oceans of planet Earth. Label them on the map.
2. In English we should be learning to write Non-Chronological Reports. Can you find out what they are? Find some examples in non-fiction books about animals from the rainforests. Locate the **title**, **headings** and **subheadings**, for example: What do they look like?, What do they eat?, An interesting fact about..... is that..... Also try to find **verbs in the present tense** (the action happens now). These are the main features of a report.  
**Extension:** Find facts about tarantulas in preparation to write a non-chronological report about them.
3. In Maths we have to learn about how to read the time. Your first task is to draw a clock face and write the hours inside using a red pen and the minutes outside of the face using a blue pen.  
**Extension:** Find out how many months, days and weeks are in one year, how many days in one week, how many hours in one day, how many minutes in one hour, etc. You can write these time facts in cards and make a quiz to play with your family.
