Hello Year 3,

This term our topic is called ‘Wish You Were Here?’ This is a Geography and History based topic about the seaside. You will need to use atlases, the internet or ask an adult to complete the tasks. Each week we are going to send you 3 activities on a Monday and 3 activities on a Thursday which you can complete at home. These activities link to what we would have been doing in class. We hope you enjoy them and if you would like to, you can keep them in a folder, a book or send us photos of your work through our class e-mails.

Here are 3 activities to start you off this week.

### English

*As our weather begins to warm up and plants and flowers begin to grow again, write an acrostic poem about Spring. For example your poem could be titled ‘sunshine’ and this title would also be written vertically, with each letter beginning your sentence. Maybe brainstorm all the words you can think of that relate to your title before you begin to write it.*

**Extension: Use a thesaurus to improve the vocabulary in your poem**

### Maths

*Recap time (which number does the long-hand point to at o’clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to?). Answer the following questions: How many hours are in one day? And in 2 days? How many days are in a week? How many weeks are in a year? Find out how many days there are in each month of the year? Do any of the number of days in each month change? If so, which month does and why?*

**Extension: Write various times using the 24-hour clock**

### Science

*Our topic this term is ‘How Does Your Garden Grow’. Write a list of what a plant needs to grow. How does this compare with what we need in order to grow strong and healthy? Are there any similarities?*

**Extension: Draw and label a flower or plant in your house or garden.**
