Option 2: I have attached 3 pieces of Maths learning from the website above and you can get reminders about how to do it and check your answers. This week is a revision of fractions. We are working on Week 3 Y6 activities from the Whiterose Maths.

Topic – NEW TOPIC - ‘**Treasure Island**’. We would like you to watch a short video clip of the story (Episode 1) see sheet for link to BBC website and answer some questions on it. The script of the story is attached with this homework. If you can get the book, it would be brilliant because we can get to know the story and all the interesting characters.
