

Birch and Tulip Home Learning Challenges

Monday 4th May



Hello to everyone in Birch and Tulip Class. Here are your new challenges for this week.

In English – Design a seed packet with written instructions on how to plant and care for your seed. Remember to use those **bossy verbs** and **time words**, such as **First, next, then** etc.

Your instructions should be **in order** so why don't you number them. Don't forget the name of your plant, its picture and the price of the packet.


Challenge: Use a different bossy verb and time word each time. No repeats!

In Maths – Last week you found a half of a shape and a group of objects by sharing into 2 equal parts. This week, let's find a **quarter**. **A quarter is sharing into 4 equal groups.**

Find some shapes around your home such as a building block, box, cup etc. and draw around them.

Cut them out and investigate whether you can fold them into quarters.

Tip: You will need to fold them into a half and then into a half again.



Challenge: Can you find a quarter of a group of objects? Share them into 4 groups. 1 of the groups = a quarter.

Is it always possible to find a quarter by folding or sharing?

In Topic – Collect the labels from different fruits and vegetables to find out where they were grown.

Make a table to show where the different plants come from.

Challenge: Can you work with an adult to find and plot these places on a map. You could use an atlas, the internet or the attached map to help you.
