I hope you like our new topic and that you are enjoying the beautiful weather! Here are some more fun activities for you to do this week.

Farm Animals and Pets

1. Let's see if you can trick me! Write a riddle about a farm animal and let's see if I can guess the animal. I will give you an example:

I have 2 legs
I have feathers and a beak
I like to paddle in a pond
I 'quack' when I speak.
What am I?

2. Farms look very different around the world. Some of them do not have animals and some of them have very different animals from the ones we have in the UK. Have a look at some farm videos on Youtube. Talk with an adult about what the farms look like? What do they have in common? And what is different? When I was little, I used to go to a very big farm in Italy, where they used to look after animals and they also had trees with lots of yummy fruits!

Now that you have learnt about different farms, it is your moment to be creative! Draw and colour or make a model of your very own farm. Choose a name for your farm and write down what animals are in it. I cannot wait to see your amazing farms!!

And here is a table of double to refresh your memory:

1+1=2	5+5=10	9+9=18
2+2=4	6+6=12	10+10=20
3+3=6	7+7=14	11+11=22
4+4=8	8+8=16	12+12=24

Now that you have refreshed your memory, it is time for some challenges:

- what is the double of 3 forks?
- what is the double of 2 straws?
- what is the double of 10 bits of pasta
- what is the double of 5 beans?
- what is the double of 7 pencils?
- create two more doubles problems for us to solve

Please remember to write your solution using math sentences.

e.g. double of 3 is 6 or $6+6=12$

You can use the real objects to help you with your doubles! Have Fun!
