This week we are thinking about different habitats. Enjoy!

## Wild Animals

1. This week we are going to think about where different animals live. We are going to use the word habitat. A habitat is the environment where an animal lives. Think of a habitat and then draw it. Once you have drawn your habitat draw some of the animals that would live there. For example, you could draw the Jungle, the Amazon Rainforest, the Desert, the Ocean, the Arctic etc....

2. Use the internet and go to Oxford Owl Reading and go to the free eBooks. We have suggested this site before. It is a free site which allows you access to a variety of eBooks that you can read together at home. These books also link to the banded book scheme we use in school.

Try reading one of the following books to your adult. Choose the book that best suits your ability.

'Ducks' Book band 1: Pink Band

'Paco's Pet' Book band 2: Red Band

'The Star Fish' Book band 3: Yellow Band

3. In maths we are going to continue sharing. You will need 10 pieces of pasta (or something else you can count). You will also need 2 plates. Cut up 5 bits of paper to make number cards. On the paper write the numbers 2, 4, 6, 8, 10.

Place the number cards face down on the table. Turn over one number card and count out that many pieces of pasta. Now share that amount of pasta between the two plates.

How many pieces of pasta end up on each plate?

Remember that you need to share the pasta equally between the 2 plates to make it fair. Repeat until you have used up all of your number cards. If you complete this and want a further challenge then you could try sharing the amounts, 12, 14, 16, 18 and 20 onto your two plates.
