Dear Year 2 families,



Here are Block 6 Week 4 Thursday's activities:

1. In Maths, we are going to try to investigate multiplication and division sentences using given numbers.

Use the number cards to make multiplication and division sentences.

How many can you make?



Extension: Use different number cards to make up your own multiplication and division sentences.

Simplification: Use 1-digit number cards. Choose two or three numbers to add together.

2. In English, we are going to look at settings. I hope you have now read the story 'The Magic Bed' by John Burningham. Imagine a setting where the magic bed takes you. This can be a real or a fantasy setting. Describe the setting using adjectives and descriptive language. Use your senses to include what you can see, hear, touch and smell.

Simplification: Draw a picture of your real or fantasy setting and write key words to describe it.

Extension: Use different sentence openers e.g. **In the distance...**, **Under my feet...**, **As I reached out....**, **As I looked up...**, **All around me...**, etc.

3. In Topic work, you can find out about deforestation. Find out how this is affecting the Amazon rainforest and the wildlife. Write about the pros and cons of deforestation. Is it a good thing or a bad thing? Why? You can present your argument in a table grid format or write in paragraphs.

Simplification: Design a poster to show either pros or cons of deforestation.

Extension: Have a debate with a family member to discuss the pros or cons of deforestation.
