

Apple and Koa Classes Home Learning Year 2

Dear Year 2 families,

As promised during this week we'll be having a zoom meeting so we can all have a chat and see each other. I will be sending the rules for this meeting on a separate email and also the link that you can click to join the meeting. We will play a little positional language game so you'll need a piece of paper, a pencil and some colours to take part.

Here are Block 6 Week 5 Monday's activities:

1. In Maths, we are going to try to **solve division problems**. Children divide by grouping objects into a given amount. They then count on to find the total number of groups. They need to do this in practical contexts, so use potatoes or pasta to help them see how to divide/share in groups. Then pictorially, this means draw pictures of the problem. Finally, they need to recognise the link between division, multiplication and repeated addition.

Mrs Green has 18 sweets. She puts 3 sweets in each bag. How many bags can she fill?

How would you draw this problem?

Which number sentence will you write to show how you solve it?

Write also the multiplication sentences to show the link in between multiplication and division. E.g:
 $10 \div 5 = 2$ so $2 \times 5 = 10$ and $5 \times 2 = 10$

Pencils come in packs of 20. We need to put 5 in each pot How many pots will we need?

Extension: Tom has 5 equal groups. The amount he started with is greater than 10 but less than 35. What could he have started with? How many will be in each group?

Simplification: Use objects to solve the problems and draw the picture that shows what you have done.

2. In English, we are going to talk about what animals you could help and why. In the story, a boy called Georgie goes on an adventure on a magic bed helping fantastic creatures and animals like a dolphin, a tiger and some geese.

Simplification: Draw a picture of the animals your character will help and label them.

Extension: Describe the animals your character will help and explain why they need help. E.g. A lonely elephant was lost from his herd and needed help finding it.

3. In Art work, we would like to explore the Art of Henri Rousseau.

Who was he? When did he paint? What kind of art did he produce? Find Tiger in a Tropical Storm.

Simplification: Can you draw a reproduction of this painting?

Extension: Chose a different painting from the artist and create your own version.
