


Tomorrow (Tuesday 23rd) marks the 72nd anniversary of the **Empire Windrush** boat arriving in Britain from Jamaica in 1948. This important event marked the first of many boats that came to Britain from the Caribbean with immigrants seeking work, a new place to live and a new life. This week we will learn a little bit about the history of the **Windrush Generation** and a bit of the Geography of the Caribbean.

Below is a blank map of the world. Here are some tasks to complete:

1. On the map, I would like you to find the Caribbean and the UK.
2. If you are able to print the map, can you plot the route the Windrush boat would have taken to Britain? If you cannot print, maybe plot a route on Google Maps on your mobile device.
3. Finally, there are 13 island nations and 12 dependant territories. **See if you can find them all!**
