Hello everybody-I hope you are still enjoying the sunshine. We continue to look forward to hearing from you. Today, I have set another three tasks and another riddle!

Riddle: Poor people have it. Rich people need it. If you eat it you die. What is it?

Now here are your 3 activities:

1 Rivers: Read through the pdf slides to find out about rivers and how they erode, transport and deposit materials. Then read the fact file and see if you can answer the questions on either sheet 2A/2B. For 2C, please use secondary sources like books, internet etc. These are differentiated so you may choose your level of challenge. You can use a dictionary to look up the words. The pdf slides and sheets (with answers) are attached.

Extension: Use a large sheet of paper to draw a picture of a river, starting at its source near the top of a mountain and ending at the mouth of the river in a sea or ocean. Label your picture using the labels on worksheet 2D. When you finish, describe the journey from the top to the bottom of the river including as many geographical words as you can.

2 English: Choose one of these images at a time and spend some time discussing ideas with your child for how this image could be a snapshot from a story. What do you think happens before and after this picture? How could you develop this so the story has a beginning middle and an end? After you've spent some time discussing, challenge children to use their ideas to write their own story.

Extension: Can you draw a scene or a character from the story?

3 Maths: These challenging Maths puzzles will help you develop a variety of Maths skills.

Extension: Play your own version to see how many points you can score.
