Riddle:What is easy to get into, but hard to get out of. What is it?

Now here are your 3 activities: **Only check the answers when you complete the task!**

1. Rivers: Read through the pdf slides to find out about why rivers are so important. Then using the picture cards, slides, internet and sheet 3A, create a fact file about why rivers are important. If you would like to challenge yourself, then use the information you have found out from the suggested sources to create an information book on river uses. Fold three sheets of A4 paper in half and staple together to create a book. Create a page for each heading provided on the 'Topic Heading' sheet. You may include pictures and personalise the book. The pdf slides and sheets are attached.

Extension: Use as much geographical vocabulary as you can and support your points with statistics, information on particular rivers, and any other specific data you can find.

- 2 English: Read the extract provided 'Witch Glade' and answer the corresponding questions on a piece of paper. Next, play the sentence opener game, which requires a dice. If you do not have one, a template has been provided for you or alternatively, pick a number from 1 – 6 each time. Once you have played a few rounds, choose your favourite sentence to use as an opening to a short story.

Extension: Show your skill as a writer by creating opportunities to use a wide range of punctuation and varied sentence types.

- 3 Maths: Today we will continue with our Maths puzzles will help you develop a variety of Maths skills.

Extension: Complete the blank time table grid provided. How long did it take you and can you beat the timer the second time round?
