Challenge

Can you use some of the words we have learnt - nocturnal, carnivore, herbivore, omnivore, snout, paws, claws, fur.

Maths: Let's learn doubles. Write the numbers 1-10 (Europe or Asia passport), 1-20 (Africa passport) on pieces of paper and put them in a cup or bag. Pick a number and work out the double.

Top tip: Remember to put the number in your head and then count on the same number again.

Can you learn them by heart?

Challenge Ask your adult to say a number. Can you say the double straight away?

Science

Make a seasons wheel.

You need 2 paper circles or plates, scissors, colouring pencils, a split pin (or drawing pin and blutac).


Draw lines to divide each plate into quarters.

On the first plate draw a picture in each quarter. Draw the 4 seasons - think about the different weather, how trees change, the clothes we wear and animals that we may see in each season.

Take the second plate and cut out 1 quarter.

Now pin the 2 circles together with the cut one on top.

Turn the top circle round to see each season.
