This term our topic is called 'We Are Authors'. Each week we are going to send you 3 activities on a Monday and 3 activities on a Thursday which you can complete at home. Here are 3 activities to start you off this week.

## 'We are Authors' - Our Favourite Stories

1. Think about a story book you love! Talk to an adult about this book.  
Make a story box of your favourite book. Decorate the inside of the box to create a scene from the story and build props to go inside it. You can use a shoe box or something similar. Use your decorated box and props to retell the story to your adult or siblings. How much of the story do you remember?
2. Listen to or watch the story "We're Going on a Bear Hunt" By Michael Rosen. If you do not have this book at home you will be able to find a video of Michael Rosen telling this story on 'Youtube'. Can you find other stories by Michael Rosen too? Which one of his stories do you like best?
3. In the story "We're Going on a Bear Hunt" the words 'Over', 'Under' and 'Through' are used. These words can be used in maths and we call them positional language.

Can you build an assault course in your house or in your garden? Practise using positional language as you complete your assault course. How many of the words below can you use?

*under, over, between, inside, on top, through,*

How many more words linked to positional language did you manage to use?
