Hi everyone,

I hope you've been enjoying the challenges so far. Here are your new ones for the week.

In English, let's look at different story from another culture. Find 'Tortoise's Dream', by Joanna Troughton on 'YouTube'. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=_TcwPrXzihQ

Watch and listen to the story - Can you make a poster of all the **adjectives** (describing words) that describe the different animals?

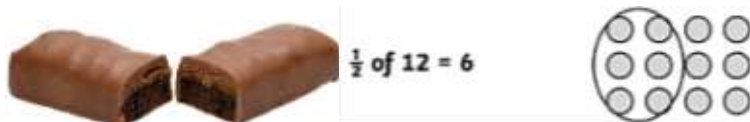
Challenge: Can you retell the story to someone at home? Try to use the **adjectives** and **repeating** sentences.

In Maths, we are going to start looking at the word **half**. To find a **half** we **divide/share** an object into 2 **equal** pieces.

Draw some shapes (you could draw around some objects you find in your home) and draw 1 line through the middle. Remember that both sides have to be **equal**.



Challenge: Can you find a half of a set of objects? **Divide/share** your objects into 2 groups. A **half** of the objects is 1 of the groups.



In Science, collect as many different types of flower as you can. Talk about the different sorts of flowers: their shapes, sizes, the numbers of petals and whether or not they are perfumed.

Use your flowers to make a collage. All the flowers should have the same amount of petals or all be the same colour, you can choose. How many can you find? You can add your own drawings and pictures from magazines too.

Challenge: Can you find out the names of the flowers in your collage?
