You could do star jumps, skipping, side-stepping, etc.</p>		<p>Make a 3D Tudor house model that will be used to burn in school to recreate the scene from the Great Fire of London.</p>	
<p>Learn a poem off by heart and perform it in front of your family or friends.</p>		<p>Write a shopping list with the prices of the items next to the pictures. Make up a problem using the items on your list. Remember to include a "change" question.</p>		<p>Go and visit a bakery shop in your local area. Write some questions to interview the baker.</p>	
<p>Write your own poem about London.</p>		<p>If you had £10 to spend, what would you spend it on? Write down how much your item(s) cost. Make sure it doesn't exceed £10.</p> 		<p>Find out what life was like in 1666. Compare with life today. Think about technology, household appliances and emergency services.</p>
