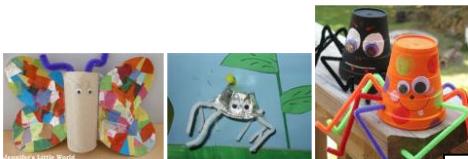


Go to the park or woods and search for minibeast. Make a list or draw all of the minibeast you find in your home learning journal.

Make a poster telling people to put their litter in the bin or to recycle.



Make a 3D junk model of a minibeast, reptile or mammal.



Create your own chart for cleaning your teeth. For one week, tick the chart every time you clean your teeth. How many ticks do you have at the end of the week? Remember we should brush our teeth twice a day!



How many nursery rhymes do you know with animals or minibeast in them? Can you sing some to your family?
