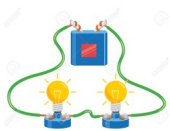

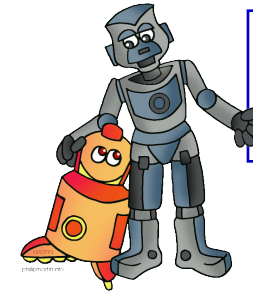
For the first half term, we will be completing our Irksome Invaders topic—looking at the Vicious Vikings.
